




GENERAL REFERENCE BOOKS

General reference books and materials (encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, etc.) shall be for room use only. General reference books may be issued for classroom use upon request of a faculty member, but these shall be returned within the day.




(Required reading materials for courses offered during the semester/summer) shall be lent for room use only and recalled two hours after it is issued.

It may also be borrowed for overnight use upon request and be returned not later than 9:00 o'clock the next working day.








THESIS, DISSERTATIONS, PERIODICALS

Theses, dissertations, and periodicals shall be for room use only. However, faculty and officials of the University may borrow a periodical, other than the latest issue, for a period of not more than one (1) week.

Books for home use are usually loaned for two (2) weeks.






OPEN ATHENS ACCOUNT AUTHENTICATION SERVICE

Open Athens Account Authentication Service enables a UPLB bonafide student to remotely access all licensed electronic resources via a single sign-on solution.

- Requests to access e-copy should be coursed through the online request portal.
- ID/ registration of the requesting student must be validated for the current semester.
- A read-only access to the requested files is given and can only be opened using the client's registered UP mail.
- Permission to view the requested materials is valid only during the current semester.

FOR TITLES AVAILABLE IN HARDBOUND

- Titles with hardbound are accessible on-site.
- Library users should submit to the library staff the filled-out request form available at the Special Collections counter.
- A valid UP school ID/ registration is deposited in exchange for the hardbound thesis/ SP.
- Used materials must be returned to the library staff in exchange for their submitted ID.

Accessing via OpenAthens

OpenAthens is a "gateway" service. With a single sign-on (SSO) using your UP Webmail login credentials (@up.edu.ph), you can conveniently access the library's electronic resources subscription on and off campus.

- 1. On your browser, go to www.openathens.net. On the landing page, click "login to MyAthens" and sign in using your OpenAthens account.
- 2. Once signed in, you will see the list of subscribed databases. Simply click on your desired database to explore its contents.

What do I need to know?



COPYRIGHT

The legal protection extended to the owner of the rights in an original work.

"Original work" refers to intellectual creation in the literary, scientific, and artistic domains.


Compilation and Derivative Works

COMPILATIONS

A compilation is a work formed by the collection and assembling of preexisting materials or of data that are selected, coordinated, or arranged in such a way that the resulting work as a whole meets the requirements for copyright protection.

DERIVATIVE WORKS

A derivative work is a work that is based on one or more preexisting works that has been transformed or modified in some way. For example, an abridged, annotated or revised edition of a book, translations and musical arrangements.



Do you need to register for copyright with IPOPHL before asserting your rights as a creator?

COPYRIGHT

The IP Code grants authors, artists, and other creators automatic protection for their literary and artistic creations from the moment they create them.







HOW FAIR IS FAIR USE?



FAIR USE

Balancing the interests of intellectual property owners with those who use it - the general public - is a key function of a healthy intellectual property system.





COPYRIGHT REFERENCE BOOK 2021

LIMITATIONS ON COPYRIGHT

The recitation or performance of a work, once it has been lawfully made accessible to the public, if done privately and free of charge or if made strictly for a charitable or religious institution or society;

The recording made in schools, universities, or educational institutions of a work included in a broadcast for the use of such schools, universities or educational institutions

The public performance or the communication to the public of a work, in a place where no admission fee is charged in respect of such public performance or communication, by a club or institution for charitable or educational purpose only







Always attribute the source of any resource you use – otherwise, you won't be able to rely on copyright exceptions for teaching or research.



Citing and Referencing

The rights of a copyright owner - the economic and moral rights - merits a separate in-depth discussion, but understanding both sides of copyright, as we play the role of both creator and consumer of it, serves as a useful guide when to

give credit where it is due

and when to express ourselves as we see fit.





TWO STEPS INVOLVES IN ACKNOWLEDGING THE SOURCE OF INFORMATION:

(1) a citation in the text of the document

(2) a reference list OR a bibliography at the end of the document









In-text Citations

You use only a few basic details

The researcher describes a virtuous person as one 'feels as he or she should, for the right reason consider circumstances" (Alvaro, 2017, p.770).



APA (American Psychological Association) used by Education, Psychology, and Sciences

MLA (Modern Language Association) used by the Humanities

Chicago/Turabian style generally used by Business, History, and the Fine Arts

The citation style sometimes depends on the academic discipline involved.
